GUARDIANSHIP

- The Headmaster requires all families living beyond the UK to have guardianship arrangements in place for their children at Ampleforth
- Guardians are expected:
  - to take responsibility for students during the short holidays or if the distance home is too great for a visit
  - to assist with travel arrangements (for example by accommodating a student overnight in preparation for a flight home)
  - to be available for emergencies such as illness or indiscipline
- Parents must agree that the guardian has full authority to incur charges and make decisions on behalf of the student and parents
- The contract with the guardian is between the parents and guardian and not between the school and the guardian

  - The Cambridge Advanced English Certificate, which is an entry requirement for British Universities

### ADDITIONAL INFORMATION

- Ampleforth is not a Language School. We expect all entrants to have a strong command of written and spoken English
- We will also require details of your child's education to date and a report from the present school. This report must assure us that the level of English is adequate for entry to the College
- The Headmaster will not normally accept a student into Ampleforth until they have visited the college for interview
- Interviews cannot be held in an applicant's home country
- Where a visit to the college cannot be arranged, it is sometimes possible to consider an application with additional information; Please contact the Admissions department for further information
- A reference from the Headmaster of the current school will also be required
- The Headmaster may require a student to take English as an Additional Language lessons as a condition of entry. EAL lessons are charged as an extra on the school bill. The present level of charges is shown on the website at [www.college.ampleforth.org.uk](http://www.college.ampleforth.org.uk)
- Parents are required to tell us of any health or disciplinary problems at the time of application
- German candidates who intend to return home for their university education must make themselves familiar with the academic requirements of their country. Some of these requirements are very strict. It is not always possible for these requirements to be met in full, particularly if a student is only at Ampleforth for the Sixth Form (A Level course).
- Spanish and Mexican students. Normally it is possible for Ampleforth to fulfil the requirements for 'convalidation' for these students
