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FURTHER NOTES:

- All items EXCEPT those marked (*) can be bought from most major high street retailers (See 'Everyday wear'). They cannot be bought in the school shop.
- All items marked (*) will be purchased and labelled with nametapes on your behalf. These items will be kept in school for your child's arrival in September.
- Further items of sportswear including waterproof sports jackets, base layers and items for use in the summer term are also available in the school shop.

DRESS CODE

Usual school dress is:

Boys: Trousers, shirt, tie (see below), jumper, jacket, black shoes

Girls: Formal knee-length school skirt/trousers, shirt, jumper, jacket, black tights and black shoes.

Sunday (formal) dress is:

Boys: Black or dark grey suit, no jumper, white shirt (tucked in), tidy collar, tie (see below), dark socks and black shoes (incl. students in years 12 & 13)

Girls: Dark suit (trousers or skirt), white shirt (tucked in), tidy collar, black tights and black shoes

Summer dress rules will apply when advised by housemasters and housemistresses during warm weather. At these times, all students may adopt summer dress as an alternative to the usual school dress.

Summer dress is:

Boys: Trousers and a shirt, with the top button undone and no tie. If a shirt with full-length sleeves is worn, the sleeves should be buttoned or else rolled neatly above the elbows. Girls: Trousers or skirt with a shirt with the top button undone. If a shirt with full-length sleeves is worn, the sleeves should be buttoned or else rolled neatly above the elbows. Trainers are not permitted.

The Sunday dress/formal attire rule remains in force during a summer dress period; on these days change to summer dress is permitted after lunch.

Ties: The official black school tie should always be worn on Mondays in remembrance of the six boys who died in a train fire on 28 April 1941. Other official school ties (Monitors, House, Colours, Activities etc) may be worn on other days.

All students are permitted to dress informally after the end of the lessons in the evening.

HAIR

Hair should be kept clean, tidy and must be of a natural colour. The length should be neither excessively long nor excessively short. Hair should be tied up in the Abbey Church (Girls).

JEWELLERY

Girls only: Single stud earrings in each ear
Single chain necklace (plain/small cross/crucifix)
One bracelet (charity or rosary type)

MAKE UP

Girls only: Discrete make up. No lipstick or bright eye shadow/liner. Clear nail varnish only.

NB: Beauty products and toiletries such as deodorant and hairspray must NOT be in aerosol cans as they present a Health & Safety risk. Any such items will be confiscated.

In matters of dispute the Deputy Head's decision is final.

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IDENTIFICATION

All articles of clothing, including footwear, must be marked with your Child's Initials, Surname, School Number and House Letter. Name tapes should be, where possible, at centre-back or waistband.
Eg: A N Smith 12345 X

LAUNDRY

Some Houses have their own washers and dryers, which can be used for a charge. There is also a School laundry. Students are responsible for sending their own laundry, which is normally returned well within the week; the exact number of certain items required will depend upon their own preference and cleanliness. As laundry is done on the School premises all clothing should be machine washable and suitable for tumble drying. Shirts should be of a polyester mixture to minimise ironing. Under no circumstances should nylon shirts be sent - these melt in the dryers. Trousers, pure wool sweaters, quilted shirts/jackets will be sent for laundering or dry-cleaning and charged separately on the termly account. The College will not accept any liability for luxury items.

BEDDING

Sheets, pillows and pillow cases are provided by the School. Parents are asked to provide a duvet and polyester type duvet covers. These should be clearly marked with your Child's Initials, Surname, School Number and House Letter. Eg: A N Smith 12345 X

OTHER USEFUL ITEMS

Your child might also find it useful to bring the following;

- a) A small padlock and key for lockable wardrobes, cupboard and tuckbox
- b) A USB memory stick to store homework/assignments on
- c) Stationary/pencil case. These are available from the School Shop but it is helpful to bring a small supply to start with
- d) A laundry bag
- e) A shoe cleaning kit
- f) A small sports bag
- g) An alarm clock or equivalent
- h) Casual clothes for leisure time
- i) A desk lamp
- j) Handkerchiefs
- k) Hair dryer
- l) A small number of spare nametapes
